

#### <u>NOTICE OF RACE</u> MIDSUMMER MADNESS DOUBLEHANDED RACE M&M Yacht Club July 25, 2024

## 1) RULES:

- a) The race will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- b) This is a double-handed race. No boat may have more than two people aboard at any time while racing.
- c) This will be a non-spinnaker/asymmetrical/gennaker race. Only one sail foresail (jib/genoa) may be hoisted in the fore-triangle.

## 2) ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

- a) The race is open to all yachts with a valid 2024 MWPHRF Certificate of Handicap and meets current USCG regulations.
- b) Entries shall complete 'Midsummer Madness Doublehanded Race' Entry Form, provide current MWPHRF Certificate of Handicap, proof of liability insurance, and pay applicable fee.

# 3) CLASSIFICATION and FEES

- a) Depending on participation, race management reserves the right to separate MWPHRF yachts into separate divisions by number of boats and handicap rating.
- b) If not registered as part of the 100 Miler Race, required fees are as follows:
  - (a) M&M Yacht Club Members \$25.00
  - (b) Non-MMYC Members \$30.00

## 4) SCHEDULE

- a) Early Registration must be completed with a yacht's 100 Miler entry and is subject to those time limits.
- b) Race Day Registration: Thursday, July 25, from 10:00-10:45 AM. No late registrations will be accepted.
- c) MANDATORY Skippers' Meeting: July 25 at 11:00 AM.
- d) First Warning: July 25 at 11:55 AM

# 5) SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND COURSE

- a) See Sailing Instructions
- b) Final course information will be distributed at the skippers' meeting. In addition, every effort will be made to have this information available 24 hours in advance of the start posted at the MM Yacht Club house bulletin board

### 6) VENUE

- a) All onshore events shall be held at M&M Yacht Club, 730 First Street, Menominee, Michigan.
- b) Racing shall take place in the waters of the bay of Green Bay starting off the NE corner of the marina wall

### 7) SCORING

- a) The race will be handicapped by PHRF "Pursuit" staggered start. Yachts will start by corrected time from slowest to fastest.
- 8) PRIZES
  - a) Awards will be awarded to the top finishers in each division. Awards will be distributed during the 100 Miler awards ceremony.
