



Notice Of Race
Round the Island Race
July 24, 2026 - M&M Yacht Club

1) RULES:

- a) The race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2) ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

- a) The race is open to all yachts with a valid MWPHRF Certificate of Handicap (or MMYC will assign a rating based on similar boats in our region) and meets current USCG regulations.
- b) Entries shall complete 'Round the Island Race' Entry Form (unless already registered for the 100 Miler Race), provide current MWPHRF Certificate of Handicap unless one is assigned by MMYC Race Committee, proof of liability insurance, and pay applicable fee.

3) Classification and Fees

- a) Depending on participation, race management reserves the right to separate MWPHRF yachts into separate divisions by number of boats and handicap rating.
- b) If not registered as part of the 100 Miler Race, required fees are as follows:
 - (a) M&M Yacht Club Members \$25.00
 - (b) Non-MMYC Members \$30.00

4) SCHEDULE

- a) Early Registration must be done with a yacht's 100 Miler entry and is subject to those time restrictions.
- b) Race Day Registration: Friday, July 24, from 8:00-9:00 AM. No late registrations will be accepted.
- c) Skippers' Meeting: 9:00 AM.
- d) First Warning: 9:55 AM.
- e) First Start: 10:00 am

5) SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND COURSE

- a) Final course information will be distributed at the skippers' meeting. In addition, every effort will be made to have this information available 24 hours in advance of the start at <http://www.mmyc.org/>

6) VENUE

- a) All onshore events will be held at M&M Yacht Club, 730 First Street, Menominee, MI.
- b) Racing shall take place in the waters of the Bay of Green Bay.

7) SCORING

- a) The race will be handicapped by PHRF "Pursuit" staggered start. Yachts will start by corrected time from slowest to fastest.

8) PRIZES

- a) Prizes will be awarded to the top finishers in each MWHRF division. Flags are distributed during the 100 Miler awards ceremonies.
