Notice Of Race
Crystal Cup Race

1) RULES:

- a) The race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- b) Crew and helm person shall be all female. One male may be allowed onboard during the race as consultant/advisor only.
- c) This is a none spinnaker race. Only one sail can be set forward of the mast at a time and attached to the forestay.

2) ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

- a) The race is open to all yachts with a valid MWPHRF Certificate of Handicap meets current USCG regulations. If a current valid MWPHRF Certificate isn't available the Race Committee may assign one based on similar boats.
- b) Entries shall complete 'Crystal Cup Race' Entry Form, provide current MWPHRF Certificate of Handicap, proof of liability insurance, and pay applicable fee.

3) Classification and Fees

- a) Depending on participation, race management reserves the right to separate MWPHRF yachts into separate divisions by number of boats and handicap rating.
- b) M&M Yacht Club Members \$25.00
- c) Non-MMYC Members \$30.00

4) SCHEDULE

- a) Race Day Registration: August 22, 2026 from 12:00 - 1:00PM.
- b) Skippers' Meeting: August 22 at 1:00 PM
- c) First Warning: August 22 1:55 PM
- d) First Start: 2:00 PM

5) SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND COURSE

- a) Final course information will be distributed at the skippers' meeting. In addition, every effort will be made to have this information available 24 hours in advance of the start at <http://www.mmyc.org/>

6) VENUE

- a) All onshore events will be held at M&M Yacht Club, 730 First Street, Menominee, MI.
- b) Racing shall take place in the waters of the bay of Green Bay.
