



**NOTICE OF RACE**  
**M&M Yacht Club**  
**Labor Day Family Race**  
**September 5th, 2026**

**1) RULES:**

- a) The race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- b) Competitors participate in this series entirely at their own risk. M&M Yacht Club, Inc. will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the series

**2) ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY**

- a) The race is open to all yachts with a valid MWPHRF Certificate of Handicap or one may be assigned by the MMYC Race Committee and meets current USCG regulations.
- b) Entries shall complete 'Labor Day Family Race' Entry Form, provide current MWPHRF Certificate of Handicap or have one assigned by the MMYC Race Committee, proof of liability insurance, and pay applicable fee.

**3) Classification and Fees**

- a) Depending on participation, race management reserves the right to separate MWPHRF yachts into separate divisions by number of boats and handicap rating.
- b) Fees are as follows:

(a) M&M Yacht Club Members	\$40.00
(b) Non-MMYC Members	\$50.00

**4) SCHEDULE**

- a) Race Day Registration: September 5th, from 8:00-9:00 AM.
- b) Skippers' Meeting: September 5th at 9:00 AM.
- c) First Warning: September 5th at 9:55 AM.

**5) SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND COURSE**

- a) Final course information will be distributed at the skippers' meeting. Typically, the course will be around Green Island Race. In addition, every effort will be made to have this information available 24 hours in advance of the start at <http://www.mmyc.org/>

**6) VENUE**

- a) All onshore events will be held at M&M Yacht Club, 730 First Street, Menominee, MI.
- b) Racing shall take place in the waters of the Bay of Green Bay starting off the NE corner of the marina wall.
- c) A club sponsored picnic lunch for skipper and crew will be provided as part of the race fee following the race at the MMYC Club House.

**7) SCORING**

- a) The race will be handicapped by PHRF "Pursuit" staggered start. Yachts will start by corrected time from slowest to fastest.

**8) PRIZES**

- a) Prizes will be awarded to the top finishers in each MWPHRF division. Awards are typically presented during the M&M Yacht Club annual banquet in October or as determined by the Social Committee.
