


WNPHRF Race Committee

PRE-START

3 people (optimum) on corner of breakwall

Display Race Committee Flag RC  and Line Flag 

Position #1; time keeper, operates horn. and calls out time to next flag (up or down)

Position #2; puts flags up and down. If Position #3 calls boat over early 'X'  flag goes up until identified boat(s) re-start by re-crossing start-line. NOTE: If boats do not re-cross starting line a 5-minute penalty needs to be added to finish time or disqualified.

Position #3; check in boats, monitors VHF radio channel 68, and monitors starting line for boats over early. If a boat is over early call out boat name and or number to Position #2. Announce on VHF 68 name of boat and "OVER EARLY". When boat restarts announce on VHF boat name and "CLEAR".

Note: If Boat does not restart make note on scratch sheet "P+5 OE" next to boat's finish time.

Monitor ... VHF 68

Note : Optional, you may announce time sequence and count-down to start for both fleets.)



Non-Spin Class

Class Flag #1 

- 1754 warning sounds... 4 short blasts

1755 Class flag up...1 short blast... 5 minutes to start






- 1756 Prep flag (P) up...1 short blast...4 minutes to start 
- 1759 Prep flag (P) down... One long blast 
- 1800 Class Flag down One long blast... **START** 

Spinnaker Class

- Class Flag #2 

- 1805 Class Flag up...1 short blast...5 minutes to start



- 1806 Prep (P) flag up...1 short blast...4 minutes to start 
- 1809 Prep (P) Flag down...1 long blast...1 minute to start 
- 1810 Class flag down.....1 long blast starting signal... **Start** 

FINISH

Position #1; spots line, calls out boat name or number of boat that is finishing. When any part of the boat (not Sail) crosses finish line Call out "mark", while sounding horn

Position #2; calls out the time when "Mark" is heard to Position #3

Position #3; records time on Race Scratch Sheet
